

**Entry to Anglo-Chinese Junior College through Drama Elective Programme**

**APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY**

Our audition panel seeks to identify students with high academic levels of theatrical studies and abilities in acting or performing arts.

Applicants are to have achieved the following minimum qualifications:

- ❖ A1 or A2 in O Level Drama

OR

- ❖ A1 or A2 in O Level English Language **and**
- ❖ A1 or A2 in O Level English Literature, History or Geography (pure) or SS / English Literature, History or Geography (elective)

AND

- ❖ Students who are highly proficient in movement or acting or performance arts are to show a record of high levels of achievement on their areas e.g. National and International Competitions and/or State Representations / international conferences / professional internships OR
- ❖ LAMDA Voice and/or Trinity Guildhall (minimum Grade 8)
- ❖ Students are to show a record of sustained and consistent academic performance throughout their secondary school career

**SELECTION PROCESS**

**1. Audition cum Interview**

- ❖ A successful audition is the key requirement for admission through this academic area of theatre studies and drama. Satisfying the abovementioned criteria does not guarantee successful direct admission into ACJC.
- ❖ Candidates are required to present one classical monologue of 5 minutes. The performance audition repertoire should be of good technical and expressive standard. This will be sent via email to the candidate once they have been invited for an audition.
- ❖ Candidates are required to present one improvised performance of 3 minutes. The performance should be of good technical and expressive standard. This improvisation brief will be issued to the candidate after

he/she has presented the monologue. The candidate will be allowed 30 minutes to prepare before presentation.

- ❖ Candidates may pre-submit their portfolios (both hard and soft copy) and demonstrate where relevant, their performance skills in areas of theatre or performing arts (eg. Dance, Choral performance, Public Speaking)
- ❖ All candidates will also be required to attend an interview.
- ❖ Students applying for Direct School Admission into Anglo-Chinese Junior College should have an exemplary disciplinary record.

## **2. Supporting Documents**

Applicants are to prepare the following supporting documents:

- ❖ Certified true copies of relevant certifications and record of achievements of dramatic arts experience.
- ❖ Previous year's academic results (3E or 4NA), and most recent current year results (4E or 5NA), if available.

**School testimonial / teacher's letter of recommendation are NOT REQUIRED. Please DO NOT request for testimonials/letters of recommendation from your secondary school.**

**Only shortlisted candidates will be required to submit the above documents when they attend the auditions/interviews.**

**Only successful candidates will be informed via email and/or phone.**

**Successful candidates, upon acceptance, must offer H2 Theatre Studies and Drama as one of their subjects and serve the college throughout their duration of study in ACJC as a member of any ACJC Performing Arts CCA considered suitable upon conversation.**
