APPLICANT ELIGIBITY

Our audition panel seeks to identify students with high academic levels and a strong interest in the Humanities.

Applicants are to have achieved the following minimum qualifications:

- Distinctions in O Level English Language and
- Distinctions in O Level History (pure) or SS / History (elective) OR
- Distinctions in O Level Geography (pure) or SS / Geography (elective) OR
- Distinctions in O Level Literature (pure) or SS / Literature (elective)

AND

- Students who are to show a record of high levels of participation and / or achievement for the Humanities e.g. National and International Competitions / Symposiums / international conferences / Research Programmes / National Presentations / Publications
- Students are to show a record of sustained and consistent academic performance throughout their secondary school career

SELECTION PROCESS

- **1.** Aptitude Test cum Interview
- A successful interview is the key requirement for admission through this academic area of the Humanities Programme. Satisfying the abovementioned criteria does not guarantee successful direct admission into ACJC.
- Shortlisted candidates are required to sit for an aptitude test, to demonstrate your knowledge and interest in the humanities, and attend an interview at ACJC. Shortlisted candidates will be sent an email with the test and interview date and time.
- Students applying for Direct School Admission into Anglo-Chinese Junior College should have an exemplary disciplinary record.

2. Supporting Documents

Applicants are to prepare the following supporting documents:

- Certified true copies of relevant certifications and record of achievements of Humanities experience.
- Secondary 3 mid-year and year-end examination results and Secondary 4 mid-year examination or most recent results (if available).

School testimonial / teacher's letter of recommendation are NOT REQUIRED. Please DO NOT request for testimonials/letters of recommendation from your secondary school.

Only shortlisted candidates will be required to submit the above documents when they attend the interviews.

Only successful candidates will be informed via email and/or phone.

Successful candidates, upon acceptance, must mandatorily join and serve ACJC through college representation, contribute to the ACJC Humanities Programme and <u>offer 3 H2 Humanities subjects</u> (from the list below) throughout their stay in Anglo-Chinese Junior College.
