Entry to Anglo-Chinese Junior College through Theatre via the Direct School Admission Exercise 2025

APPLICANT ELIGIBITY

Our audition panel seeks to identify students with high levels of theatrical talent and abilities in acting or performing or technical arts.

Applicants are to have achieved the following minimum vocal qualifications:

LAMDA Voice and/or Trinity Guildhall (minimum Grade 6) / O Level Drama or equivalent

And/or

Students who are highly proficient in movement or acting or technical arts are to show a record of high levels of achievement on their areas e.g. National and International Competitions and/or State Representations / international conferences / professional internships.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. Face-to-face Audition cum Interview
- Not all eligible applicants will be shortlisted as candidates.
- ❖ A successful audition and interview is the key requirement for admission through this area of theatrical talents. Satisfying the abovementioned criteria does not guarantee successful direct admission into ACJC.
- ❖ Candidates are required to present a performance comprising of one classical **and** one contemporary monologue of 5 minutes each. The performance audition repertoire will be of good technical and expressive standard and will be issued by ACJC if the candidate has been shortlisted. An invitation will be sent via email to the candidate once they have been shortlisted for an audition.
- Candidates with technical arts applications must pre-submit their portfolios (both hard and soft copy) and demonstrate where relevant, their technical skills in areas of theatre arts such as but not limited to **lighting** or **sound** at interviews.
- All candidates will also be required to attend an interview.
- Students applying for Direct School Admission into Anglo-Chinese Junior College should have an exemplary disciplinary record.

2. Supporting Documents

Only shortlisted applicants are to prepare the following supporting documents in softcopy prior to the audition and submit via email:

- Certified true copies of relevant certifications and record of achievements of dramatic arts experience.
- Secondary 3 year-end examination results and Secondary 4 mid-term examination reports or most recent results (if available).

School testimonial / teacher's letter of recommendation are not required. Please DO NOT request for testimonials/letters of recommendation from your secondary school.

POST-AUDITION MATTERS

- After the selection process, only successful candidates will be notified via email and/or phone.
- Unsuccessful DSA candidates are still welcome to apply for admission to ACJC through their own academic merit via JAE and encouraged to join the ACSian Theatre.
- Successful candidates, upon acceptance, must mandatorily join and contribute to the ACSian Theatre throughout their stay in Anglo-Chinese Junior College.
