What characteristics do Oxbridge look for in students?

- Serious academic subject interest
- Good 'fit' between a student's interest and aptitude, and their chosen course
- The student selected is among the most able and committed students in the college
- Strong performance in examinations (better than the typical student)
- Ability to think critically and learn independently
- Capacity for demanding workload (~45 hours per week)
- Core knowledge and technical fluency
- Natural curiosity
- Vocational commitment (where appropriate for your proposed subject)

Singapore-Cambridge GCE Advanced Levels

The minimum offer level would typically be AAAA at H2 Level, or AAA at H2 plus at least a Merit at H3. Applicants should take relevant H3 subjects where these are available to them. All offers will be based on individual circumstances.

The Cambridge Colleges welcome applications from those taking Knowledge & Inquiry as a fourth H2 (contrasting subject). If you plan on taking Knowledge & Inquiry as one of your three 'subject relevant' H2s please contact the College that you wish to apply to directly for further advice and guidance.

Trinity College has additional requirements - you should check Trinity's website for more information.

Pre-Admissions assessments and tests

- You should not select pre-admission test dates that clash with either college preliminary exams or actual A levels exams by registering early and taking note of the registration deadlines. Do your due diligence.
- Both Oxford and Cambridge require applicants in specified subjects to sit an admissions assessment/test in advance of shortlisting for interview.
- •You need to register for these tests and should consult the relevant Oxford, Cambridge and Pearson VUE admissions assessment/test web pages.
- •Key and up-to-date information and past papers are available via our websites
- Students need to practise against the clock using past papers
- You should revise subject content in technical subjects

Format of interviews

- Interviews = interactive aptitude tests
- Interviews range in number and length, but the most common format is two interviews of 20-30 minutes each
- Conducted by subject specialists
- Online at Oxford and at most (but not all) Cambridge colleges
- Problem-solving scenarios and discussion
- They assess your:
- 1. Subject interest
- 2. Core subject knowledge
- 3. Technical aptitude
- 4. Logical reasoning
- 5. Intellectual flexibility
- No hidden agenda and no trick questions

Medicine/ Dentistry in the UK

- International students are subjected to a quota in the UK for medicine
- Do your due diligence to check whether the medical degree awarded by the UK university is recognised by the Ministry of Health (MOH) and Singapore Medical Council (SMC)
- Check on the pre-admission tests needed for the UK university degree.

Application to University of Oxford and Cambridge

Important NOTE: Candidates are **not** allowed to apply to both University of Oxford and University of Cambridge in the same year.
